April 19, 2021

The regular meeting of the City of Cottonwood Falls was called to order at the Municipal meeting room. Agenda

City Clerk's Report

Utilities Supervisor

Jones brought a Proposal and Contract for APAC for street work on the following streets: Vine, Locust, Friend, Main, Oak, 2nd, and various street repairs. Larkin made a motion to sign proposal and contract with APAC. Hastings seconded. Motion carried.

Jones updated Council he is waiting on estimates from Emporia Construction and Remodeling for quotes on sidewalks.
