

# CITY OF COTTONWOOD FALLS

## ORDINANCE NO. 1003

**AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AND INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE FOR KANSAS CITIES, 41<sup>ST</sup> EDITION FOR THE CITY OF COTTONWOOD FALLS, KANSAS.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COTTONWOOD FALLS, KANSAS:**

### **SECTION 1. UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE INCORPORATED:**

- (a) Adopted: there is here by incorporated by reference for each purpose of regulating public defenses within the corporate limits of the City of Cottonwood Falls, Kansas that certain code ordinance known as the *Uniform Public Offense Code for Kansas Cities – 41<sup>st</sup> Edition*, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas. No fewer than one copy of said of said Uniform Public Offense Code shall be marked or stamped “Official Copy” as Adopted by Ordinance No. 1003, and to which shall be attached a copy of this ordinance and filed with the City Clerk to be open for inspection and available to show any such omissions, deletions, modifications, or changes, and to which shall be attached a copy of this article or said ordinance and filed with the City Clerk to be open for inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours. The Police Department, Municipal Judge and all administrative departments of the city charged with enforcement of the ordinance shall be supplied, at the cost of the city, such number of official copies of such Uniform Public Offense Code similarly marked , as may be deemed expedient.

### **SECTION 2. K.S.A. 12-009 to 12-3012 AND VIOLATIONS CONFLICTS.**

- (a) Any violations of any section of this ordinance that prescribes or requires the same behavior as the prescribed or required by statutory provision that is classified as a uniform public offense in K.S.A. 12-3009 to 12-3012, avoiding the need to publish the entire code in the newspaper.
- (b) All public offenses and violations that are included within this ordinance and which are not in conflict with state laws, traffic laws or local ordinances shall be considered public offenses.

**SECTION 3 EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall take effect from and after its publication the official city newspaper, The Council Grove Republican.
