ORDINANCE No. 1007

AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO THE FIFA 2026 WORLD CUP; PROHIBITING LIMITATIONS BY MUNICIPALITIES AUTHORIZING ANY CITY TO ALLOW THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES 23 HOURS A DAY, SEVEN DAYS A WEEK FOR THE DURATION OF THE FIFA 2026 WORLD CUP, AMENDING K.S.A.12-1692 AND REPEALING THE EXISTING SECTION.


The Governing Body of the **City of Cottonwood Falls, Cottonwood Falls, KS** is enacting **House Bill No. 2481 - New Section 2.**

- a). Notwithstanding the provisions of K.S.A. 41-712, 41-2614, 41-2653, 41-2704 and 41-2911, and amendments thereto, for the duration of the **FIFA 2026 World Cup** commencing on **June 11, 2026 and continuing through July 19, 2026**, any entity licensed under the Kansas Liquor Control Act, the Club and Drinking Establishment Act or the Kansas Cereal Malt Beverage Act **that is authorized to sell alcoholic liquor or cereal malt beverage in the original package** or for the consumption on the premises may sell alcoholic liquor or cereal malt beverage in accordance with the applicable statutes and rules and regulations governing the sale of such alcoholic liquor or cereal malt beverage by such licensee between the hours of 6:00 am and 5:00 am on the immediately following the day if such entity is located in a city or described in subsection b).
- b.) The board of county commissioners of any county may, by resolution, or the governing body of any city may, by ordinance elect to allow the sale of alcoholic beverage as described in subsection a).
- c). Upon the adoption of any such resolution or ordinance, the clerk of such county or city shall submit a copy of such resolution or ordinance to the Director of the Alcoholic Beverage Control.
- d). As used in this section, "**FIFA 2026 World Cup**" means the international soccer tournament conducted every four years that is organized by the Federation Internationale de Football Association and set to be held in the United States, Canada, and Mexico in 2026.
- e). Any ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby temporarily repealed through the dates of June 11, 2026, through 5:00 am on July 20, 2026.

Adopted on the 4th day of May 2026, this ordinance will be published in the Official City Newspaper and signed by the **Mayor of Cottonwood Falls** with the approval of the **City Council of Cottonwood Falls, Kansas.**
