



Swope Park R.V. Park Rules and Regulations

Violation of these rules may subject violator/camping unit to removal from the Park

- Site Fees are payable in advance (No exceptions).
- All campers and camping units are limited to a stay of not more than fourteen (14) consecutive days although an extension may be obtained with written permission from the City Clerk (620-273-6666) if the party requesting such extension has verifiable, temporary employment in the surrounding area, as a contractor or sub-contractor, an extended stay may be granted. A fourteen (14) day absence is required before returning to the park to camp again. Any property left unused or unoccupied for 48 hours shall be considered abandoned, and is subject to removal by the city, without notice.
- All R.V.'s and vehicles, etc. must be contained within your designated site.
- Your site must be kept neat, clean, and free of boxes, litter, or trash. No appliances, storage bins, weight sets, etc. are allowed. No junked, unusable, or unsightly vehicles will be allowed in the Park. Contact the City Clerk (620-273-6666) for questionable items.
- Businesses are not allowed to be run from the campgrounds.
- Pets are welcome in Swope Park. There is a leash law in Cottonwood Falls which prohibits dogs running at large. Please clean up after your pet.
- Charcoal grills & wood smokers may be used at the campgrounds unless the County is under a burn ban. Propane and pellet grills are the only grills allowed when under a burn ban.
- No major vehicle repairs shall be made on these premises. Service work including changing oil and lubing is prohibited.
- Any cutting of trees or plants is prohibited.
- Restrooms and showers are accessible 24 hours a day; please help keep them neat and clean. Report any problems immediately.
- Loud parties, excessive drinking, offensive language, or other unacceptable behavior by guests is not permitted.
- Any unlawful behavior will not be tolerated on city property. If authorities have to be contacted for any unlawful activity perpetrated by you or anyone staying at or visiting your site, you may be required to leave.
- Clotheslines are not permitted.
- Dispose of your trash in the poly-carts provided. Do not leave trash outside your unit overnight. All garbage must be placed in plastic bags and tied. Boxes must be flattened.
