The regular meeting of the City of Cottonwood Falls was called to order at 7:00 p.m., December 7, 2015 at the municipal meeting room.

Those present were Mayor Boyce Baumgardner, Council Members Buddy Sisson, Carl Studer, Bob Sturms, Shawn Taylor & Pat Larkin, City Attorney Laura Allen, Utilities Supervisor David Jones, and City Clerk Tiffany Bohnen.

Agenda

Sisson made a motion to approve the Agenda. Studer seconded, motion carried.

Minutes

Larkin made a motion to approve the minutes from November 16, 2015. Studer seconded the motion. Motion carried, with Sturms abstaining.

Scheduled Visitors

Mike Holder & Jon Weiss appeared before the Council to present a 10 year extension to the Chase County Neighborhood Revitalization Plan. The plan would allow for citizens that make home improvements that increase the assessed value at least \$10,000 or citizens that build a new home to receive a tax rebate. The rebate would last 5 years; the first year participants would receive 100% tax rebate, then 80%, 60%, 40%, 20% in the years thereafter. Sturms made a motion to adopt Ordinance No. 960 amending a Neighborhood Revitalization Plan and continuing a designated Neighborhood Revitalization Area. Studer seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Mayor's Report

- Sisson made a motion to enter into a 10 minute executive session to discuss nonelected personnel at 7:27 p.m. Studer seconded the motion. Motion carried.
- Meeting reconvened at 7:37 p.m. Sturms made a motion to give the City Employees a Christmas bonus. Sisson seconded the motion. Motion carried.
- Sisson made a motion to authorize the mayor to sign the engagement letter from Cosgrove,
 Webb & Oman for the proposed issuance of the Cottonwood Falls Public Building Commission
 Revenue Bonds for the Swimming Pool Project. Studer seconded the motion. Motion carried.
- Highway Permit 2-15-177 has been approved by KDOT, granting permission to install a native limestone welcome marker on K-177 on the north edge of Cottonwood Falls. Council is currently waiting on estimates for the lettering of the sign.

City Attorney's Report

Allen is waiting to receive the updated city boundaries from Geotech.

City Clerk's Report

- Clerk Bohnen has been proofreading the Code Book. She is requesting that each Council member read over it to look for any errors.
- Councilman Larkin agreed to discuss issues with Dorneker regarding the enforcement of the Dangerous Structures.
- Bohnen has received a request from KVOE to sponsor four regular season games. No action was taken.

• The Wave will be broadcasting the boys and girls basketball games on December 11th and February 12th. The cost per night is \$69 and includes 5-15 second ads in the girls and boys games. They will also be broadcasting the semi-final and final games, so if Chase County is in either of those rounds they would broadcast those as well. Larkin made a motion to approve sponsoring the 2 regular season games and the Flint Hills Shootout, if the Bulldogs play in the semi-finals and/or final games at \$69 per night.
