- Ty Wilson appeared before Council to give an update on the progress of the Spring Creek water service. Jones believes that the 4' pipe that Wilson was quoted will be too big and the water will not be able to meet state regulations. Jones suggested that Wilson get in touch with an engineer to determine what size should be used.
- Lisa Vega, 96.1 The Wave presented options for radio advertisement for Veteran's Day and Country Christmas. Sturms made a motion to purchase the Veteran's Day package consisting of 20 fifteen second ads to run 10 times on November 10 and November 11 for \$100. Studer seconded the motion. No action was taken on the Country Christmas ads.
- Kristen Lawrence appeared for the Dangerous Structure hearing for 220 7th St. Enforcement
 Officer Rich Dorneker was also present. Dorneker reported that substantial improvements have
 been made on the property and recommended the property be removed from the Dangerous

- Sisson made a motion to engage Cooper Malone McClain, Inc. to initiate the formation of the Public Building Commission, made up of the Mayor of Cottonwood Falls, the City Council of
