ORDINANCE NO 966

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE I OF CHAPTER 4 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF COTTONWOOD FALLS, KANSAS, 1991, RELATING TO THE NATIONAL BUILDING CODE BY REPEALING ARTICLE I OF CHAPTER 4 AND ADOPTING ALTERNATIVE PROVISIONS THEREFORE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COTTONWOOD FALLS, KANSAS, THAT:

SECTION I. Article I of Chapter 4 of the code of the City of Cottonwood Falls, 1991, relating to the National Building Code abbreviated, referenced and known as ordinance 797, is hereby repealed and the provisions hereinafter set forth are enacted in lieu thereof, to-wit:

4-101. BOCA NATIONAL BUILDING CODE, 2015.

The BOCA National Building Code, Edition of 2015, a standard for building as recommended by the Building Officials and Code Administrators International, Inc., 4051 W. Flossmoor Rd., Country Club Hills, Illinois 60478-5795, the same being a standard code for the control of buildings and structures and available in book or pamphlet form, shall be and is hereby incorporated by reference thereto.

SECTION 2. All ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be effective from and after its publication in the official City newspaper Chase County Leader-News.
