

**ORDINANCE NO 979**

**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PUBLIC OFFENSES WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF COTTONWOOD FALLS, KANSAS; INCORPORATE BY REFERENCE THE "UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE FOR KANSAS CITIES," EDITION OF 2018.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COTTONWOOD FALLS, KANSAS:**

**SECTION 1.** INCORPORATING UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE. There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating public offenses within the corporate limits of the City of Cottonwood Falls, Kansas, that certain code known as the "Uniform Public Offense Code," Edition of 2018, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas. No fewer than three copies of said Uniform Public Offense Code shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Adopted by Ordinance No. 976," and to which shall be attached a copy of this ordinance, and filed with the city clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours.


**SECTION 2.** All Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.



**SECTION 3.** This ordinance shall be effective from and after its publication in the official city newspaper, The Chase County Leader-News.
