## **ORDINANCE NO. 973**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF COTTONWOOD FALLS, KANSAS, 1991, RELATING TO THE NATIONAL BUILDING CODE BY REPEALING ARTICLE I OF CHAPTER 4, THE ELECTIC CODE BY REPEALING ARTICLE 2 OF CHAPTER 4, THE PLUMBING CODE BY REPEALING ARTICLE 3 OF CHAPTER 4 AND ADOPTING ALTERNATIVE PROVISIONS THEREFORE AND ADDITIONAL FUEL GAS, RESIDENCE AND MECHANICAL CODES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COTTONWOOD FALLS, KANSAS, THAT:

SECTION I. Article I of Chapter 4 of the code of the City of Cottonwood Falls, 1991, relating to the National Building Code abbreviated, referenced and known as ordinance 966, is hereby repealed and the provisions hereinafter set forth are enacted in lieu thereof, to-wit:

4-101. International Building Code, 2012.

SECTION 2. Article 2 of Chapter 4 of the code of the City of Cottonwood Falls, 1991, relating to the National Electric Code abbreviated, referenced and known as ordinance 786, is hereby repealed and the provisions hereinafter set forth are enacted in lieu thereof, to-wit:

4-202. National Electric Code, 2005.

SECTION 3. Article 3 of Chapter 4 of the code of the City of Cottonwood Falls, 1991, relating to the National Building Code abbreviated, referenced and known as ordinance 796, is hereby repealed and the provisions hereinafter set forth are enacted in lieu thereof, to-wit:

4-301. International Plumbing Code, 2012.

SECTION 4. Any provision of the code of the City of Cottonwood Falls, 1991, relating to the International Residence Code, International Fuel Gas Code, and International Mechanical Code abbreviated other than the 2012 version, is hereby repealed and the provisions hereinafter set forth are enacted in lieu thereof, to-wit:

International Residence Code, 2012. International Fuel Gas Code, 2012. International Mechanical Code, 2012.

SECTION 5. All ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall be effective from and after its publication in the official City newspaper Chase County Leader-News.
